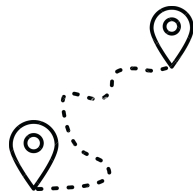

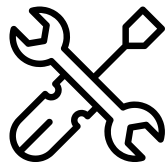

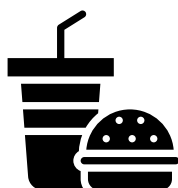

## **Tour Description**

The Camino de Santiago along the coast is an easy alternative when compared to the more traditional Portuguese routes. The final destination remains the same, but the challenges are within the reach of the vast majority of cyclists.

Before starting the pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela, enjoy a tour of the city of Porto with us. You will get to know a little about its architecture, heritage and local traditions.

On the way to Santiago, you will pass through several destinations with plenty of sun and beach, such as Esposende, Caminha and Bayona. Enjoy the famous oysters of Arcade and understand why Caldas de Reis holds a noble importance. Finally, we will reach the Praça de Obradoiro, where the colossal Baroque cathedral stands as the burial place for the remains of the apostle Santiago.

## **Route Description**

Flat route during the first three days with few gentle and short climbs. Hilly on the last three days on secondary roads.

30% cycle paths and walkways, 30% smooth dirt paths. Some parallel streets and uneven dirt paths. 20% paved roads with little traffic.

Accumulated elevation of 4121 meters.

## **Itinerary 7 nights / 8 days:**

Day 1: Reception in Porto

Day 2: Porto - Esposende (60 km)

Day 3: Esposende - Caminha (50 km)

Day 4: Caminha - Baiona (40 km)

Day 5: Baiona - Pontevedra (64 km)

Day 6: Pontevedra - Caldas dos Reis (26 km)

Day 7: Caldas dos Reis - Santiago de Compostela (40 km)

Day 8: Transfer to Porto

## ➤ **Dia 1: Receção no Porto**

Before starting your journey to Santiago de Compostela, it is almost a must to explore Porto, classified as a World Heritage Site and Capital of Culture and Tourism. Join us on a walking tour of the city and discover some of the heritage that this city has to offer. Discover famous places such as the bookstore that influenced J.K. Rowling's Harry Potter book, the magnificent stock exchange market, the blue and white tiles that are hidden around every corner and much more. Art, heritage and traditions await you throughout this short tour of the city. Accommodation, 4\* Hotel: (Hotel to be designated)

## ➤ **Day 2: Porto > Esposende (60 km)**

You will start your journey towards Esposende from the Porto Cathedral. During this first day, you will see countless seaside landscapes, as well as small "Portuguese rivieras". You will pass through a huge variety of fishing villages, such as Póvoa de Varzim, where you can witness ancient fishing traditions and where you can taste its famous cuisine. In Vila do Conde, you will understand why these coastal towns were so important during the golden age of the Portuguese Discoveries. Accommodation, 4\* Hotel: (Hotel to be designated)

## ➤ **Day 3: Esposende > Caminha (50km)**

Viana do Castelo is the main city you will pass through. This serves as another fine example of a seaside anchorage city, with an ancient connotation and enormous importance during the Discoveries.

During the 14th and 15th centuries, this city was the site of the development of ships that set sail for Brazil, India, Africa and other Portuguese colonies. Their final destination will be Caminha. This city is located on the delta of the Minho River, forming part of an incredible landscape. The city of Caminha is widely known for its natural heritage, such as hiking areas, waterfalls, beaches and a campsite. Accommodation, 4\* Hotel: (hotel to be designated)

## ➤ **Day 4: Caminha > Baiona (40km)**

On this day we will start by crossing the Minho River and disembarking in Spanish territory. Your destination, Baiona, is a city politically linked to Pontevedra, where you can breathe in the sea breeze. In addition to the seascape, you can lose yourself in the old city centre, which was born from Roman roots and grew towards the coast during the Middle Ages, with the influence of the Catholic Church. Interestingly, during the 16th century, Baiona was invaded by British ships led by the great corsair and explorer Francis Drake, who saw an opportunity to establish a commercial and mercantile base in this territory. Accommodation, 4\* Hotel: (Hotel to be designated)

## ➤ **Day 5: Baiona > Pontevedra (64km)**

From the Vigo estuary to the San Simon bay, you will have a seascape to feast your eyes on. Following the coastline, this day will be dedicated to Arcade and its famous oysters.

In addition to this delicious delicacy, you can also see monuments and tourist attractions dedicated to the culture of Santiago, such as the church of Santiago in Arcade, from the 12th and 13th centuries, and the roads and paths that will take you to your pilgrimage destination. It is almost obligatory to pass through Arcade and enjoy the famous oysters, produced and harvested in the waters of the region. During the first week of April, a festival dedicated to this traditional cuisine takes place, the "Fiesta de la Ostra", where the city is full of tourists and pilgrims who come from far and wide to take part in this event. Accommodation, 4 \* Hotel: (Hotel to be designated)

## ➤ **Day 6: Pontevedra > Caldas de Reis (26km)**

According to historical records, Caldas de Rei has its origins in a pre-Roman community that lived off the hot springs of this territory. Its name is linked to the birthplace of Alfonso VII, at a time when it was already a pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela. In addition to its rich cultural heritage, as an Arcade, Caldas de Reis maintains a unique gastronomy, such as lamprey "empanadas" and traditional Spanish bread. Since the hot springs accompanied the evolution of this territory, today it is a tourist attraction for those seeking healthier treatments for various illnesses. Accommodation, Rural House: (Hotel to be designated)

## ➤ **Day 7: Caldas de Reis > Santiago de Compostela (40km)**

The last and seventh day will be spent traveling from Caldas de Reis to Santiago de Compostela, our final destination and one of the centers of religious pilgrimage in Western Europe.

Like Rome and Jerusalem, the city of Santiago de Compostela presents itself as a unique religious icon for tourists, who find this cycling trip an act of faith and inner fulfillment. You will arrive at the Plaza de Obradoiro, where you will have the opportunity to contemplate the majestic Baroque cathedral, where the remains of the apostle are located. Accommodation, 4\* Hotel: (Hotel to be designated)

## **Day 8: Departure**

Day to return to Porto after breakfast and check out of the Hotel.

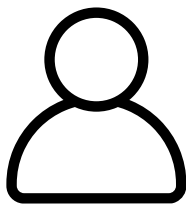
